## **Wauline Dixon (Mansfield)**

DEC 9, 1917 - JUN 10, 2013

**W**auline Wave Dixon, daughter of William and Serena Claxton Thornhill, was born December 9, 1917 near Grovespring, Missouri and departed this life on June 10, 2013 in Rocky Ridge Manor in Mansfield, Missouri at the age of ninety-five years, six months and one day.

On June 15, 1935 she was united in marriage to Gene Dixon and to this union three children were born.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband Gene, on May 7, 1994, two sisters, Bessie and Freda, one brother, Glenn, and a son-in-law, Dennis McNealy.

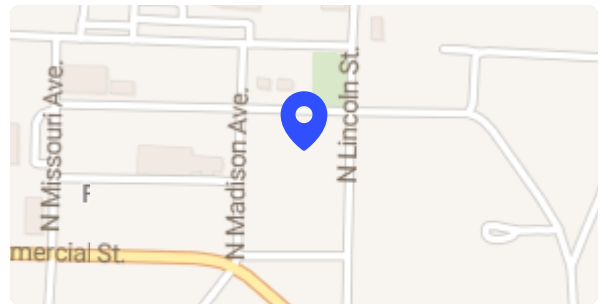

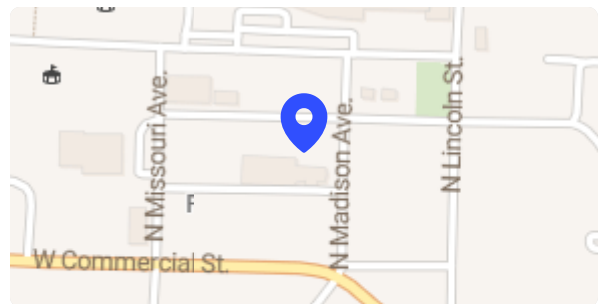

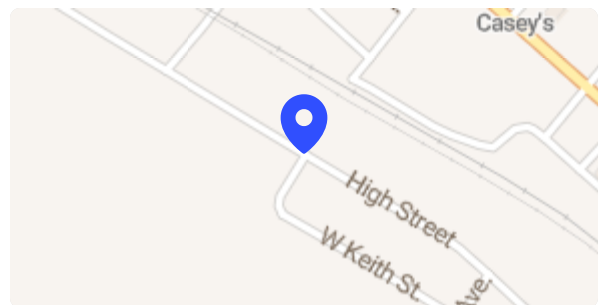
