She departed this life Friday, June 28, 2013, in Christian Health and Rehabilitation Center South, in Lebanon, Missouri, at the age of ninety-two years, two months, and twenty-five days.

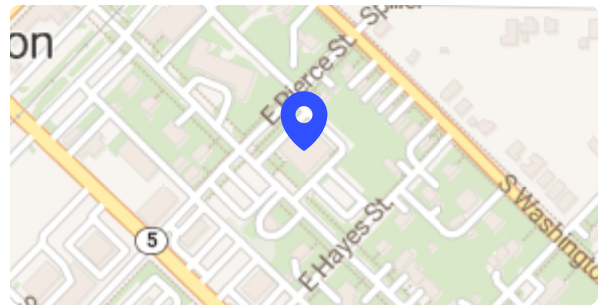

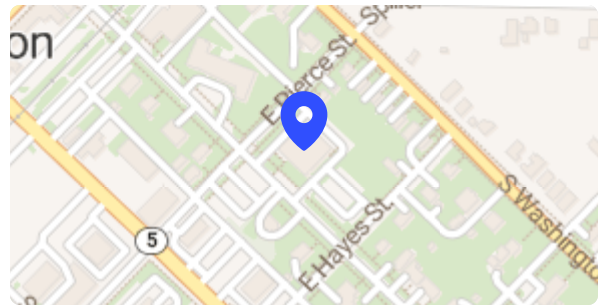

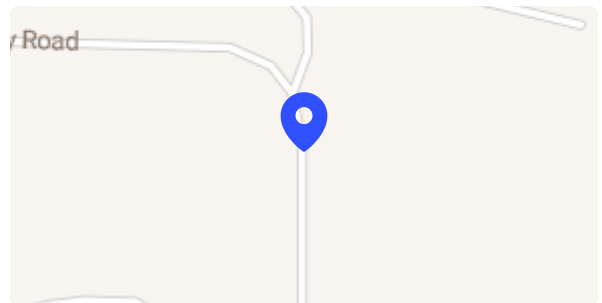
