## **Charles D. Cornelison (Lebanon)**

MAR 19, 1935 - NOV 14, 2013

**C**harles Dean Cornelison, son of Rev. William L. and Myrtle Alice Bailey Cornelison, was born March 19, 1935, near Yukon, Missouri. He departed this life Thursday, November 14, 2013, in his home, near Lebanon, Missouri, at the age of seventy-eight years, seven months, and twenty-five days.

He was preceded in death by his parents; and an infant sister, Darlene Cornelison. He purchased a farm in the Lebanon, Missouri area, and operated it for many years. He also worked in building construction throughout his life.

Charles had professed his belief in Christ and followed the Freewill Baptist faith throughout the years. He was a caring, Christian man who followed Jesus and was always willing to help someone in need; seeing the good in everything and everyone.

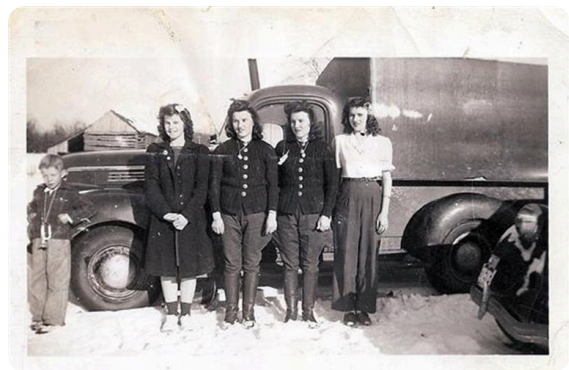
