**J**ames Ivan Wynn, son of James C. and Edith Hightower Wynn, was born October 29, 1935 near Hartville, Missouri and departed this life on March 22, 2014 in his home in Mansfield, Missouri at the age of seventy-eight years, four months and twenty-three days.

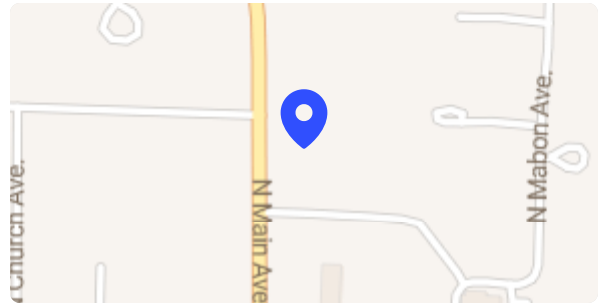

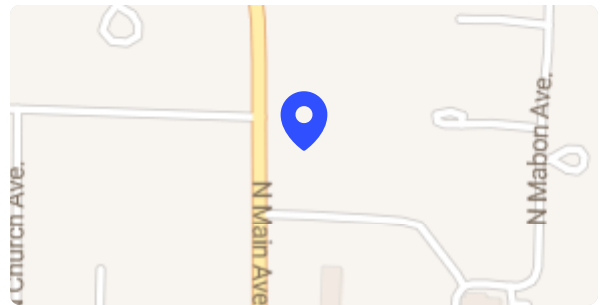

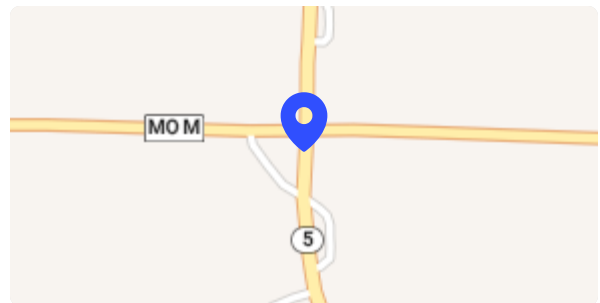
