Jimmy "Fiddlin' Jimmy" Wilson (Lebanon)

OCT 18, 1933 - APR 8, 2014

Jimmy Lee Wilson, son of Willie and Mattie Enyart Wilson, was born October 18, 1933, near Drynob, Missouri. He departed this life Tuesday, April 8, 2014, in Mercy Hospital, in Lebanon, Missouri, at the age of eighty years, five months, and twenty days.

He was preceded in death by his parents; an infant daughter, Martha Jane Wilson; three brothers, Milburn, Floyd, and Wilburn Wilson; and two sisters, Louise Decker, and Lillian Doublin Martell.

"Fiddlin' Jimmy", as he was affectionately called, is survived by a son, Fred Wilson, of Lebanon, Missouri; a daughter, Erica Smith, and her husband, Ben, of Lebanon, Missouri, and Bonnie, of Roby, Missouri; one grandchild, Hayden Smith, of Lebanon, Missouri; a sister, Lucy Pierce, of Kansas City, Missouri; his significant other, Leah Stroud, of Lebanon, Missouri; as well as a host of other relatives and friends.

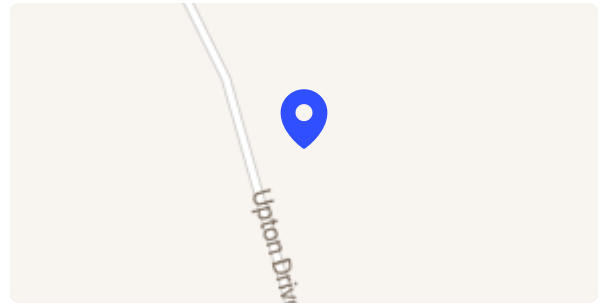

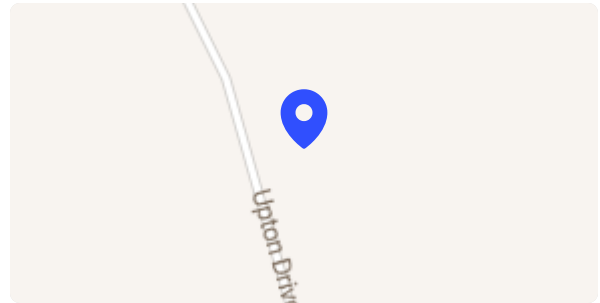
