## **Raymond Otis Looney (Lebanon)**

**R**aymond Otis Looney, son of Charley and Leola McGuire Looney, was born January 11, 1945, near Decaturville, Missouri. He departed this life Saturday,

December 27, 2014, in Mercy Hospital, in Springfield, Missouri, at the age of sixty-nine years, eleven months, and sixteen days.

On February 5, 1966, he was united in marriage to Fern Bohannon, and to this union two daughters were born. He was preceded in death by his parents; a daughter, Teresa Rock; and a sister, Virginia Gregory.

Raymond is survived by his loving wife of forty-eight years, Fern, of the home; one daughter, Ramona Lucas, and her husband, Danny, of Strafford, Missouri; four grandchildren, Christopher, Michael, Christina, and Ethan; a brother, Lester Looney, and his wife, Judy, of Springfield, Missouri; several nieces and nephews; as well as a host of other relatives and friends.

He was born and raised in the Decaturville community, and graduated from Lebanon High School. 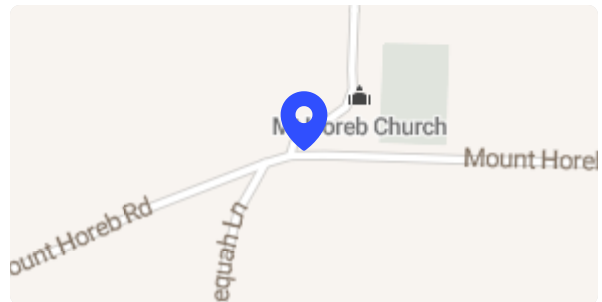
