Leroy Morrison, son of Roy Lee and Gracie M. Webb Morrison, was born September 23, 1935, near Decaturville, Missouri. He departed this life Thursday, January 22, 2015, in Christian Health and Rehabilitation Center South, in Lebanon, Missouri, at the age of seventy-nine years, three months, and twenty-nine days.

On September 24, 1954, he was united in marriage to Lavern Clough, and to this union one daughter and two sons were born.

He was preceded in death by his parents; five brothers, Clyde, Claudie, Johnnie, Jesse, and Jimmie Morrison; and a sister, Ida Looney.

Leroy is survived by his loving wife of sixty years, Lavern, of the home; a daughter, Kathy Conn, and her husband, Walter, of Lebanon, Missouri; two sons, William Morrison, of Lebanon, Missouri, and Steven D.
