## **James "Jim" Gregory (Hartville)**

**J**ames Dale Gregory, son of Everett Lee and Nettie Arlie Wood Gregory, was born October 6, 1943 in Hartville, Missouri. He departed this life February 27, 2015 in Harlingen Medical Center, Harlingen, Texas, at the age of seventy-one years, four months, and twenty-one days.

On March 29, 1964, Jim was united in marriage to Letah Kay Keith, and together they shared nearly fifty-one years of marriage.

Jim was preceded in death by his parents; two sisters, Arlyene Rippee and Marie Garner; and three brothers, Donnie, Gene, and Gerald Gregory.

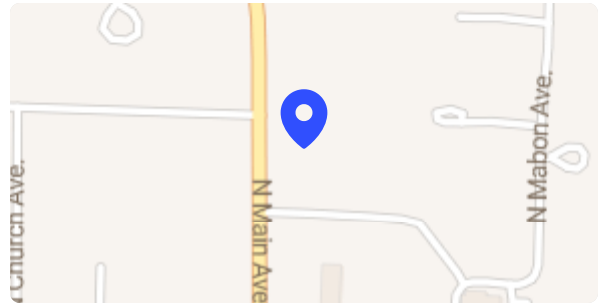

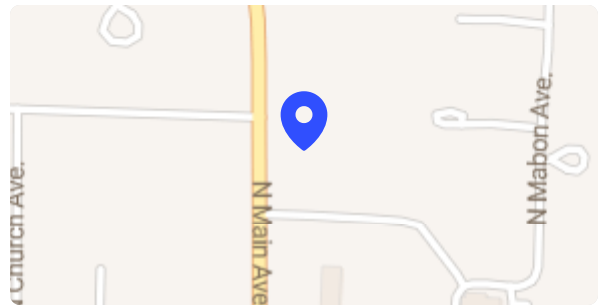

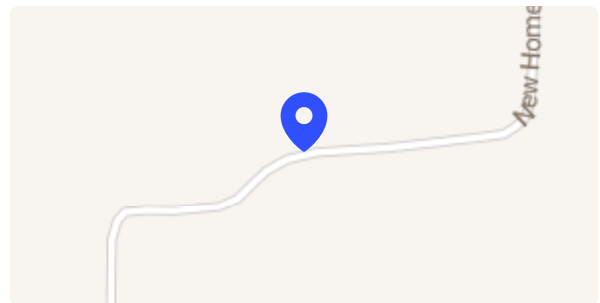
