We celebrate his life and will cherish the many wonderful memories we had with him.






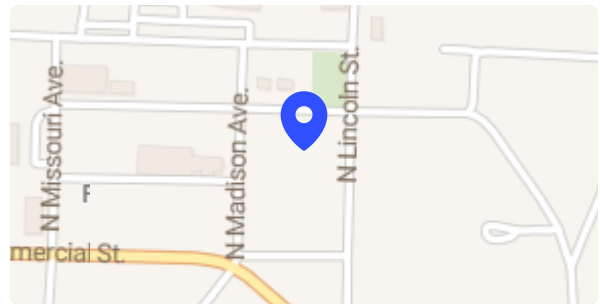

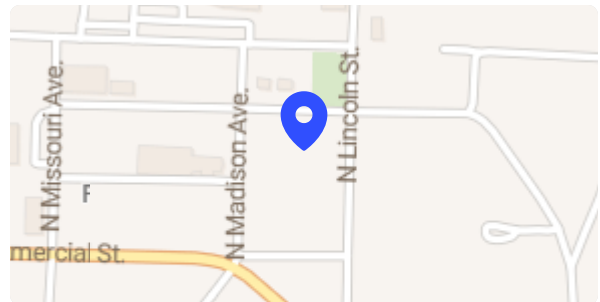

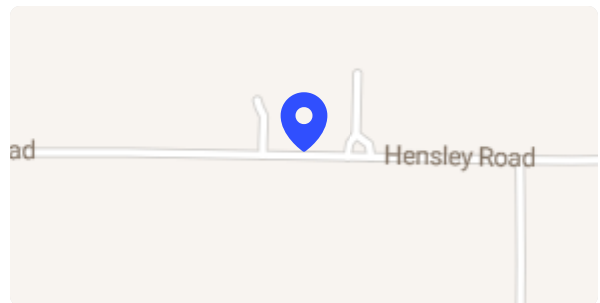
