Rex will be sadly missed by all his family, friends and neighbors. Especially his friends in the neighborhood club.



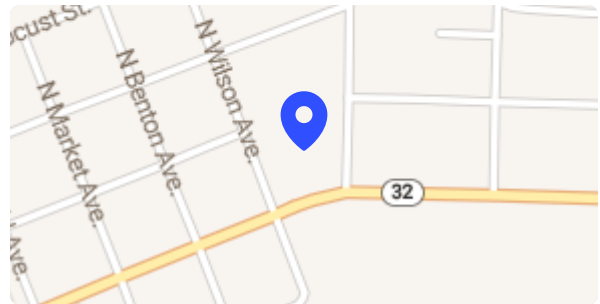

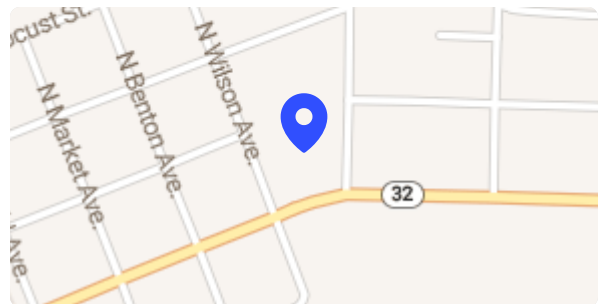

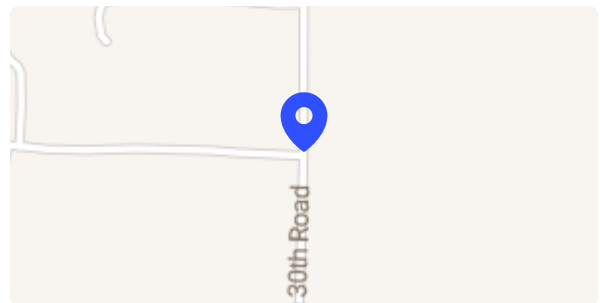
