On September 7, 1957, she was united in marriage to Johnny Vernon Williams, and they shared forty-six years before his passing on June 5, 2003.

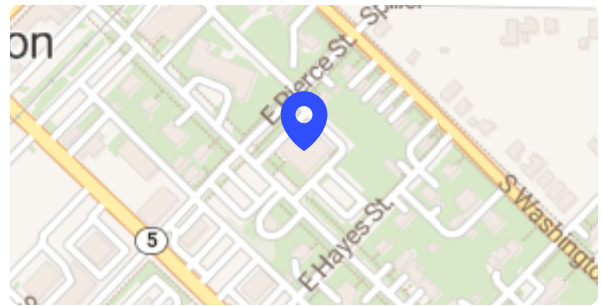

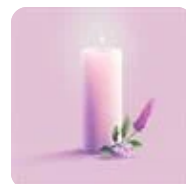
