## **Barbara June Carr (Lebanon)**

**B**arbara “Pat” June Carr, daughter of John and Marguerite Hatfield Carter, was born January 27, 1925, in Anthony, Kansas. She departed this life Tuesday, December 29, 2015, in Northridge Place, in Lebanon, Missouri, at the age of ninety years, eleven months, and two days.

On October 9, 1943, she was united in marriage to John Kenneth Carr, and to this union one daughter and two sons were born.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband of fifty-five years, Kenneth, on May 31, 1999; a granddaughter, Elisha Kathryn Knight; and a sister and brother-in-law, Betty and Richard Frazee.

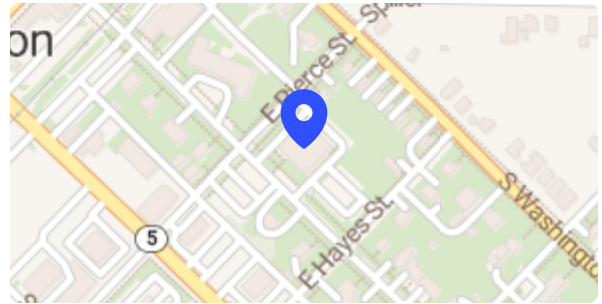

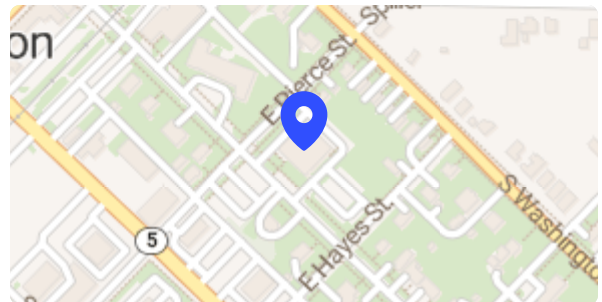

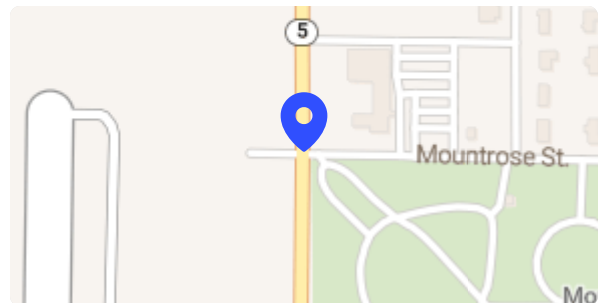
