Lillian Faye Hutcheson, age 89, of Bolivar, Missouri passed away on Wednesday evening, November 24, 2010 at Parkview Healthcare Facility in Bolivar, Missouri. She was born February 18, 1921 in Mountain Grove, Missouri to John Henry Hicks and Mabel Ann (Hartzog) Hicks.
