Albert Clark Miller, Jr., son of Albert Clark Miller, Sr. and Josephine Ardell Powell Miller, was born November 1, 1925, in West Salem, Oregon. He departed this life Sunday, October 4, 2009, in St. John's Hospital, in Lebanon, Missouri, at the age of eighty-three years, eleven months, and three days. On February 22, 1981, he was united in marriage to Nellie Tennessee Elrod Rowlett, and together they shared twenty-four years before her passing on November 12, 2005. He was also preceded in death by his parents; a stepson, Dewayne Rowlett; a brother, George; and four sisters, Alma, Ardell, Elizabeth, and Irene. For the next several years, Albert and Nellie traveled and lived in various places before settling in Lebanon, Missouri, in 1995. Albert had made his profession of faith in Christ and was a member of Hillcrest Baptist Church in Lebanon. In his spare time he enjoyed being outdoors where his favorite activities were fishing and hunting. He also volunteered his time at the Free Store in Lebanon for several years.
