**N**ora Lee Neill, 85, Bolivar, MO, passed away Thursday, March 3, 2016 at Park View Health Care in Bolivar, MO.

Nora Lee (Wright) Neill was born April 30, 1930, in Aldrich, Missouri to Marvin and Lucille (Courtney) Wright. She passed away at Parkview Health Care Facility in Bolivar, on March 3, 2016. She grew up on a farm in Aldrich, Missouri and was a fifth generation Polk County Resident. Nora Lee graduated from Aldrich High School in 1948 as Valedictorian of her class.

On March 4, 1950, she and Thomas J. Neill were married in Fair Play Missouri. They celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary in 2000. In 1956, Nora Lee began working for the Polk County ASCS-USDA and was an exemplary employee for thirty-two years. 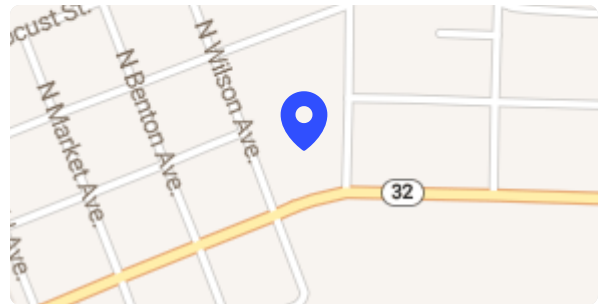

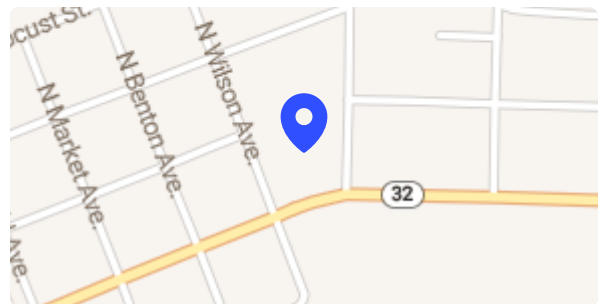

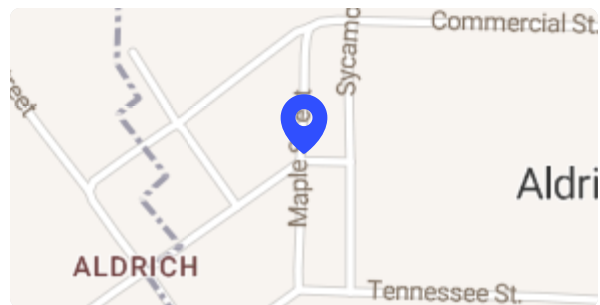
