William Sterling Lippy, Jr. was born January 1, 1934, in Westminster, Maryland. He departed this life Sunday, May 7, 2017, in his home, near Lebanon, Missouri, at the age of eighty-three years, four months, and six days. On January 1, 1959, he was united in marriage to Eleanor Hazel Hopkins, and to this union one son was born.

He was preceded in death by his parents, William S. Lippy, Sr. and Helen M. Lippy; and two sisters, Dorothy Ebaugh, and Irene Uhler.

He then returned to Maryland and after he and Eleanor were married, they made their home in Baltimore and lovingly raised their son. William was employed by General Electric Corporation for twenty-seven years, beginning as a truck driver and then working in the warehouse. In 1984, the family moved to Missouri, and made their home in Laclede County. William owned and operated Laclede County Contractor for the next twenty years.

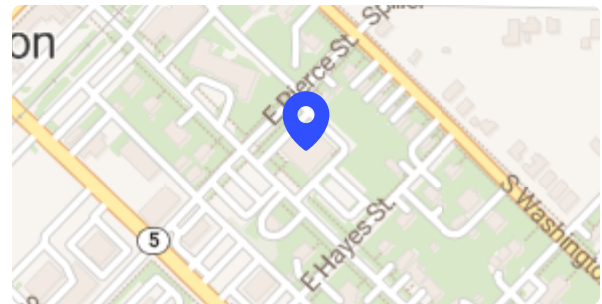

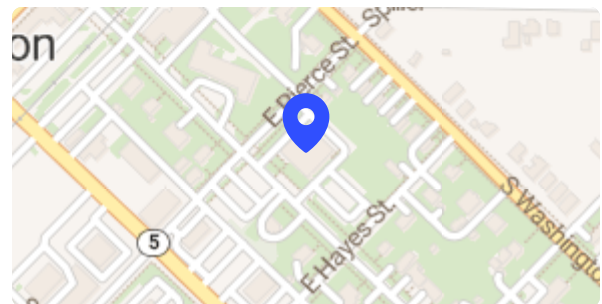

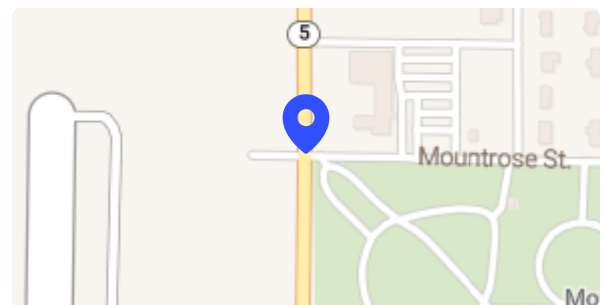
