**M**artin Lloyd Crowell, son of Howard M. and Barbara Newcomb Crowell, was born May 6, 1958, in Evansville, Indiana. He departed this life Friday, June 9, 2017, in his home, near Lebanon, Missouri, at the age of fifty-nine years, one month, and four days.

He was preceded in death by his father; and his wife, Dana Crowell.

He soon started having health issues but remained strong and tough. He had a fondness for animals, was a gun lover, and loved rock and roll music, especially his favorite bands, Led Zeppelin, Guns N Roses, and Black Sabbath. When he spoke, people listened and he would quietly stand his ground. He loved his family and especially enjoyed his grandson.
