James Edward Scott, age 73, passed away in the comfort of his home on October 26, 2017 in Halfway, Missouri, surrounded by family. 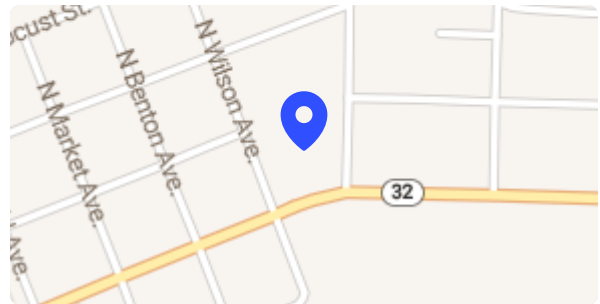

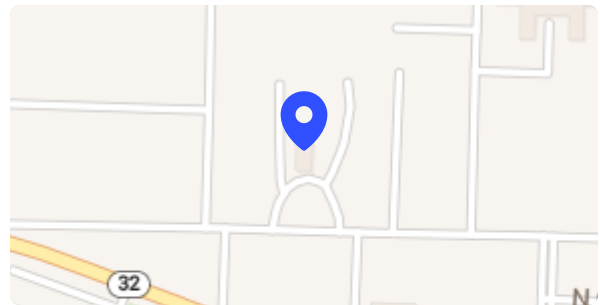
