On October 20, 1951, she was united in marriage to Willie Ray Beagh, and to this union one daughter and four sons were born.

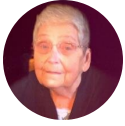
She was preceded in death by her parents; and her husband, Willie, on January 28, 2012.

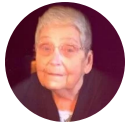
