Marie Helen Boone, daughter of Clarence Henry and Grace Frances Blakeley Sharp, was born November 22, 1928, in Lebanon, Missouri. She departed this life Tuesday, January 30, 2007, in her home, in Lebanon, Missouri, after a short and courageous battle with pancreatic cancer and with the loving care of her son, at the age of seventy-eight years, two months, and eight days.
