Wilma Lucinda “Cindy” Cauthron, daughter of Thomas Elijah and Evie Ellison Matthews, was born August 29, 1932, in Goodhope, Missouri. She departed this life Tuesday, April 19, 2011, in St. John’s Hospital, Springfield, Missouri, at the age of seventy-eight years, seven months, and twenty days.
