Ivin Orville DeVault, son of Fred and Erma King DeVault, was born October 1, 1923 in Fort Scott, Kansas. He departed this life Wednesday, February 20, 2008 at Doctor's Hospital, in Springfield, Missouri at the age of eighty-four years, four months, and nineteen days. On January 29, 1942, Alvin was united in marriage to Julia Mae Waters and together they shared fifty-eight years until Julia's passing on February 20, 2000.
