**C**arl W. Eidson was born in Macks Creek, Missouri on January 13, 1939 to Jess Sterling and Maryann Meads Eidson. He passed away on Tuesday, February 15, 2012 at his home in Macks Creek, Missouri.

He went his first year of school in the old schoolhouse, next to Pleasant Grove Missionary Baptist Church, which he helped remodel several years later.
