## **Lottie Hicks (Lebanon)**

JUL 29, 1915 - JUL 5, 2011

**L**ottie Jo Hicks, daughter of Hiram and Carolyne Buttram Perryman, was born July 29, 1915, near Grovespring, Missouri. She departed this life Tuesday, July 5, 2011, in Webco Manor, in Marshfield, Missouri, at the age of ninety-five years, eleven months, and six days.

On June 10, 1934, she was united in marriage to Norman Franklin Hicks, and to this union two sons were born.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Norman, on May 10, 2001; a granddaughter, Heather Hicks; and a brother, Elvin Perryman.
