Robert Hagan Hurd, son of Oliver Paul and Francis Floyd Hurd, was born July 20, 1933, in Louisiana, Missouri. He departed this life Wednesday, March 5, 2008, in Maranatha Village, in Springfield, Missouri, at the age of seventy-four years, seven months, and fifteen days. On May 21, 1953, he was united in marriage to Elizabeth Ann Creel, and to this union two sons were born. His parents preceded him in death.
