**M**ary Nell Kennedy, daughter of Ira Crockett and Ottolean (Siler) Archer was born September 23, 1929 in Bethel Springs, Tennessee. She departed this life Saturday, September 11, 2010 in her home in Fordland, Missouri at the age of eighty years, eleven months and nineteen days.

On April 27, 1947 she was united in marriage to Nathel "Nate" Kennedy and to this union a son and three daughters were born. Nate preceded her in death on May 30, 1991. She was also preceded in death by a daughter, Marilyn; her parents; a grandson, Aaron Pinson; one sister, Jewell Pierce; and a brother, Raymond Archer.
