She departed this life Tuesday, March 9, 2010, in Phelps County Regional Medical Center, in Rolla, Missouri, at the age of ninety-five years, three months, and nine days. On September 20, 1937, she was united in marriage to Cleve Harrison Kissinger, and to this union one daughter and one son were born. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Cleve, on February 3, 1994; and a sister, Mable George.
