He departed this life Monday, May 1, 2006, in St. John's Regional Health Center, in Springfield, Missouri, at the age of seventy-two years, seven months, and seventeen days. On September 15, 1978, he was united in marriage to Marie Anne Kuchnicki and together they have spent the past twenty-seven years. He was preceded in death by his parents, and an infant brother.
