**K**evin Dean O'Quinn, son of Olan Harrison and Virginia Appling O'Quinn, was born February 11, 1960, in Lebanon, Missouri. He departed this life Thursday, December 30, 2010, in his home, in St. Charles, Missouri, at the age of fifty years, ten months, and nineteen days.

His father preceded him in death.
