**S**herman Everett Porter, son of Everett and Grace Kinkade Porter, was born March 7, 1952, near Niangua, Missouri. He departed this life Friday, June 4, 2010, in his home, in Lebanon, Missouri, at the age of fifty-eight years, two months, and twenty-seven days.

On May 1, 1970, he was united in marriage to Connie Sue Martley, and to this union two daughters and one son were born.
