Michael Camp, adored dad, grandpa and great-grandpa, departed this life with loved ones by his side the morning of Tuesday, July 30, 2019, at his son's residence in Fordland, Missouri. Mike, or 'Camp', as he was known to most, was sixty-seven years, nine months and seventeen days of age at his passing.

One of five children, he was born Michael Lee Camp on October 13, 1951, in Springfield, Missouri, to William Carl and Mary Lee (Pepper) Camp. He grew up in Cave Spring, Missouri, and attended Willard schools.
