Bobby Gene Graham, son of Gene and Clema Dennis Graham, was born July 11, 1936, in Linneus, Missouri. He departed this life Friday, August 9, 2019, in his home, in Lebanon, Missouri, at the age of eighty-three years, and twenty-nine days. On July 16, 1965, he was united in marriage to Evelyn Christy and they shared the last fifty-four years.

He was preceded in death by his parents; two grandsons, B. J. and J. R.; a brother, Jim; and a sister, Dee.

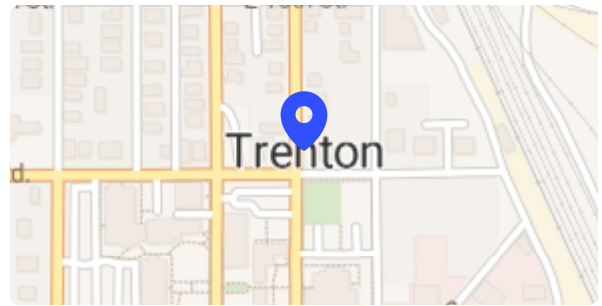
