**Y**vonne Irene Goodwin, daughter of Clarence and Elva Kennett Thomas, was born March 29, 1923, in Old Linn Creek, Missouri. She departed this life Wednesday, November 13, 2019, in Mercy Hospital, in Lebanon, Missouri, at the age of ninety-six years, seven months, and fifteen days.

On April 4, 1944, she was united in marriage to Lowell C. Goodwin, and to this union two daughters and one son were born.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Lowell, on January 5, 1978; a son, Kenny Goodwin; a son-in-law, Michael Logue; a great-granddaughter, Cassandra Reed; six brothers, Clarence Jr., Kennie, Floyd, Toy, Loraine, and Olon; and two sisters, Eden and Opal.

A memorial has been established to Claws and Paws.






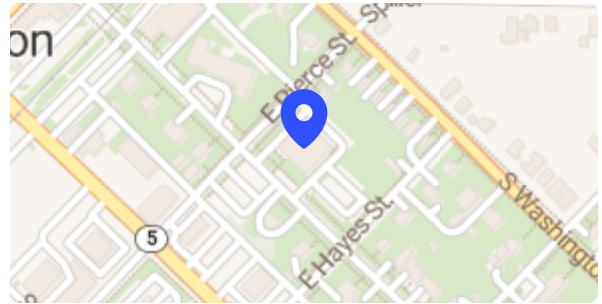

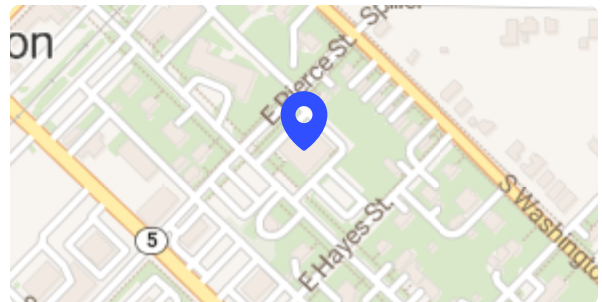

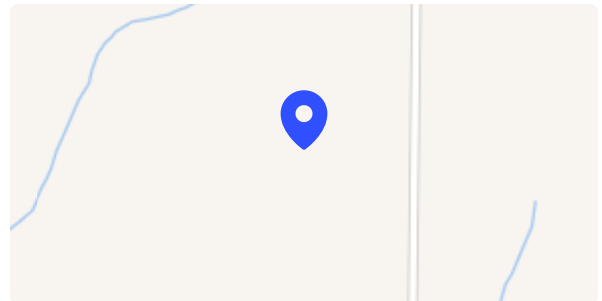
