Virginia Lee Craver, daughter of Lowe and Edna (Chambers) Moore, was born September 15, 1934 in Wright County, Missouri. She departed this life early Tuesday morning, February 4, 2020 in the Hartville Care Center at the age of eighty-five years, four months, and twenty days.

In 1979, Virginia was united in marriage to Clarence “Ace” Craver and the two were together until his passing in 1992.
