Harold Lee “Hal” Emerson, son of Harold G. Crum and Ann Ward Emerson, was born November 11, 1938, in San Antonio, Texas. He departed this life Thursday, February 13, 2020, in Lebanon North Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, in Lebanon, Missouri, at the age of eighty-one years, three months, and two days. He was united in marriage to Barbara Jean Gement, who preceded him in death. He was also preceded in death by his parents; and two sisters, Barbara and Janet. “Hal”, as he was called by all of his family and friends, is survived by a son, Doug Crum, and his wife, Virginia, of Lebanon, Missouri; two daughters, DaLinda Wellington, and her husband, Brian, of Albany, Oregon, and Kerri Smith, of the State of Arizona; eight grandchildren; six great-grandchildren; several nieces and nephews; as well as a host of other relatives and friends.

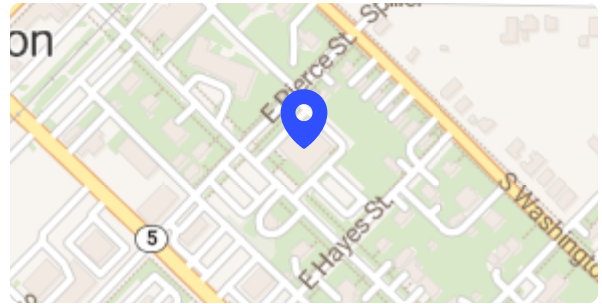
