Patty Lou Calton, daughter of Oscar Newton and Velma Rabania Ward Claxton, was born June 14, 1934, in Competition, Missouri. She departed this life Thursday, February 20, 2020, in her home in Lebanon, Missouri, at the age of eighty-five years, eight months, and six days.

On January 14, 1970, she was united in marriage to David D. Calton, and they shared twenty years before his passing on January 10, 1990.

She was also preceded in death by her parents; a son, Mark Wynacht; a brother, Jimmy Claxton; and a sister, Kathryn Robertson.

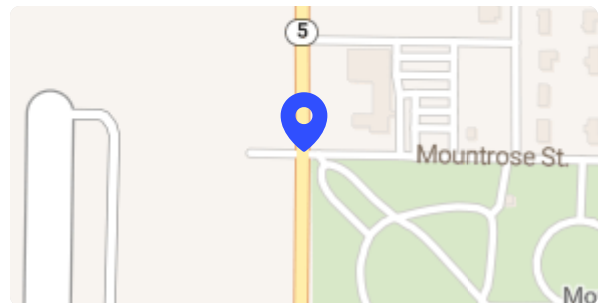

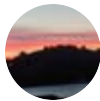
