**G**lenn Eugene Alford, son of Oreth “Bid” and Muriel “Dolly” Melvin Alford, was born December 9, 1934, in Grovespring, Missouri. He departed this life Tuesday, March 17, 2020, in Lebanon South and Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, in Lebanon, Missouri, at the age of eighty-five years, three months, and eight days. On October 13, 1956, he was united in marriage to Elizabeth A. Keesling, and to this union one daughter was born.

His parents preceded him in death.

Glenn is survived by his loving wife of sixty-three years, Elizabeth, of the home; a daughter, Patricia Crenshaw, and her husband, Thomas, of St. Charles, Missouri; two grandsons, Jeffery Crenshaw, and his wife, Carrie, and Andrew Crenshaw, all of St. Charles, Missouri; a great-grandson, Colt Crenshaw, of St. Charles, Missouri; a sister-in-law, Iris Keesling; as well as a host of other relatives and friends.
