A memorial has been established to the Flatwoods Cemetery and donations may be left at the funeral home.



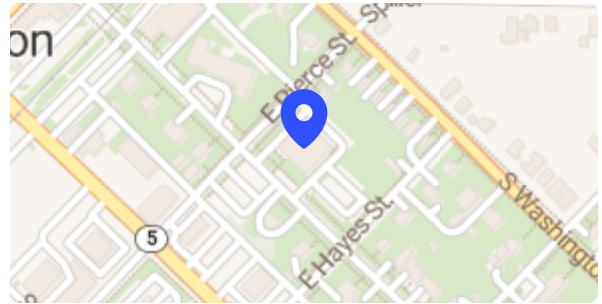

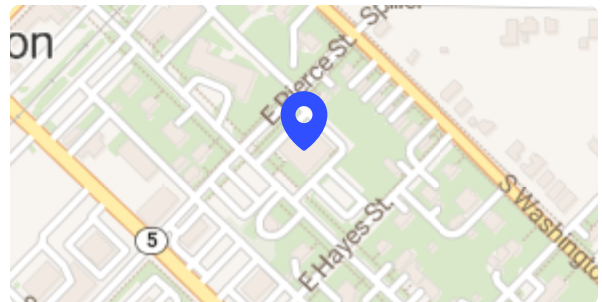

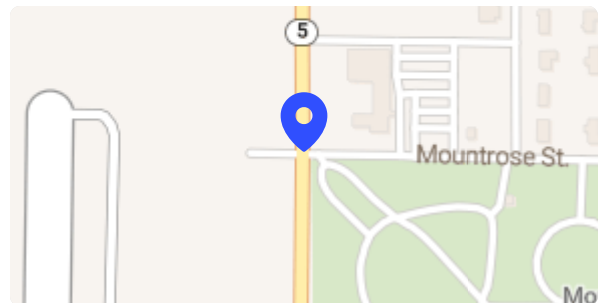
