**W**illiam Douglas "Doug" McGuire, son of Paul McGuire and Judy Webster, was born July 16, 1966, in Lebanon, Missouri. He departed this life Thursday, September 6, 2012, in Barnes Jewish Hospital, in St. Louis, Missouri, at the age of forty-six years, one month, and twenty days.

On June 30, 1990, he was united in marriage to Paula Sue "Susie" Murphy, and to this union one daughter was born.

Doug is survived by his wife, Susie, of the home; a daughter, Summer McGuire, and her fiancé, Huey Seely, of Osage Beach, Missouri; his mother, Judy Webster, of Lebanon, Missouri; his father, Paul McGuire, of Lebanon, Missouri; a brother, Todd McGuire, and his wife, Debbie, of Gardner, Kansas; a sister, Paula Archer, and her husband, David, of Lebanon, Missouri; several nieces and nephews; as well as a host of other relatives and friends.

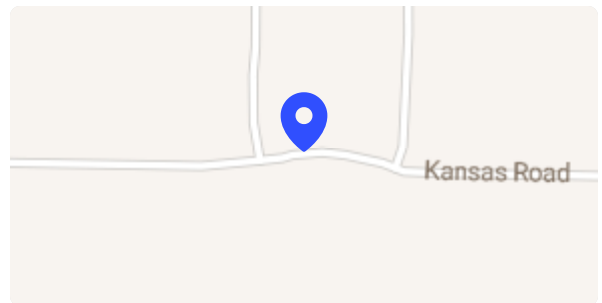
