Daughter of Luke A. Feathergill Sales and Pauline Roenna (Workman) Sales, Roberta was born on November 17, 1919 in Ozawkie, Kansas. She was raised in Topeka during the Depression era and later moved with her family to Lawrence. Roberta enjoyed the simple things of life, playing with her seven brothers and sisters, going to baseball games and seeing movies. It was there that she meet the love of her life, James “Dick” Ireland and the couple was wed on June 11, 1938. To this union the couple was blessed with a son and a daughter. 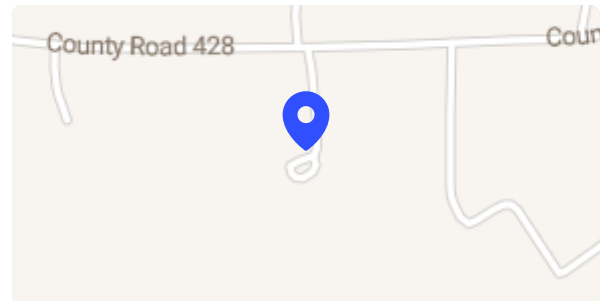

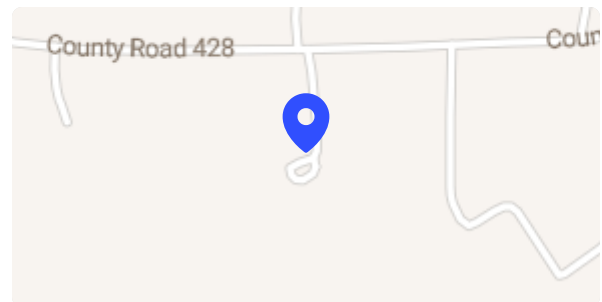

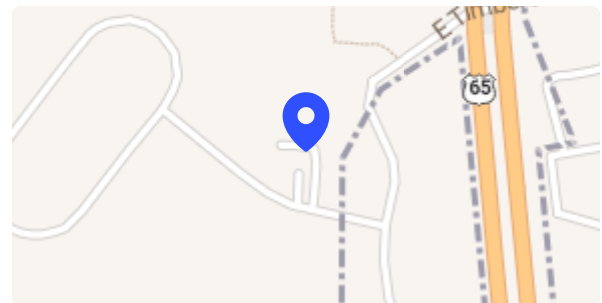
