Pam was a loving sister, aunt, caring neighbor and friend. We celebrate her life and accomplishments and will cherish the wonderful memories she created for her family and friends.






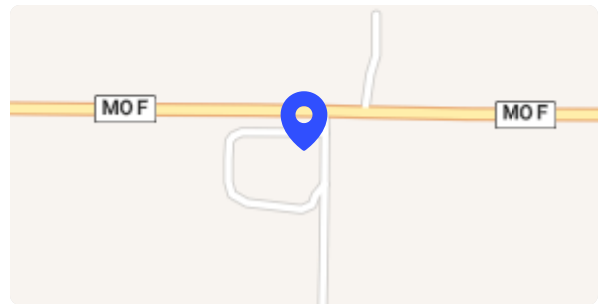
