**C**harlotte Alma Watson Medley, daughter of Harry and Alma Haldiman Meyer, was born September 3, 1929, in Jamestown, Missouri. She departed this life Monday, September 21, 2020, in Mercy Hospital, in Lebanon, Missouri, at the age of ninety-one years and eighteen days.

On October 5, 1948, she was united in marriage to Jack David Watson, and to this union five sons were born. Jack passed away on January 29, 1997 in Cape Girardeau, Missouri.

On August 21, 2004, she married Raymond Medley, Jr. and they shared the last sixteen years.

She was also preceded in death by her parents; two brothers, Harry Meyer and John Meyer; and a sister, Carmen Layman.

Charlotte is survived by her husband, Raymond, of the home; five sons, Steve P. 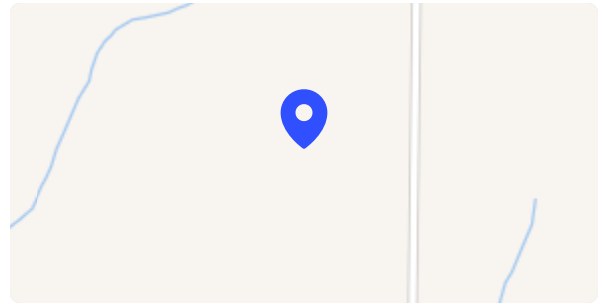

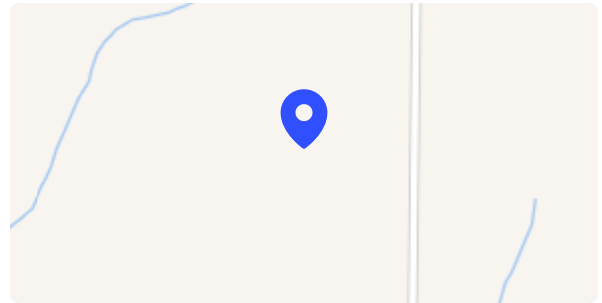

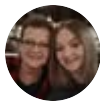
