Private burial in Liberty Cemetery will follow visitation.



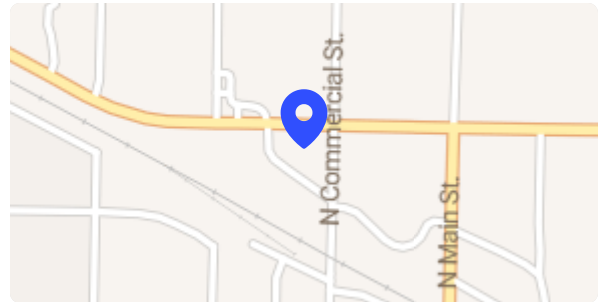

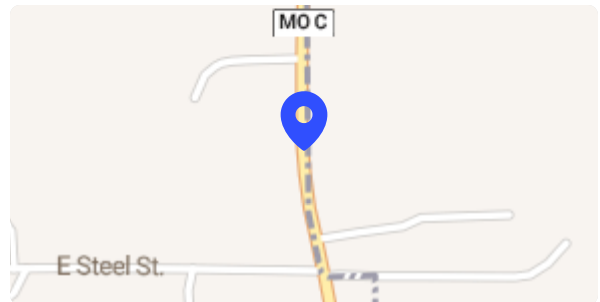
