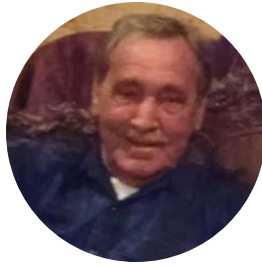

A memorial to the Old Bolles Cemetery has been established and contributions may be made through the funeral home.






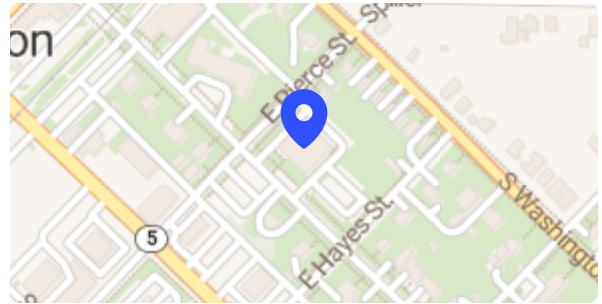

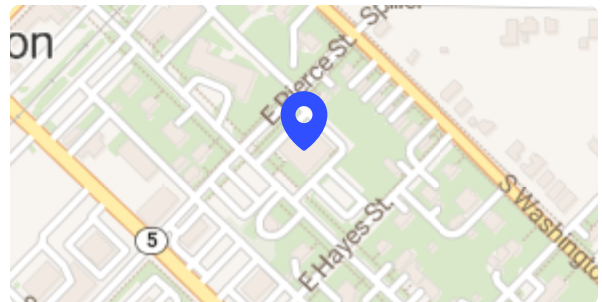
