Scotty met his wife Judy while singing with a gospel quartet. Judy played the piano for the group. After Scotty's time in the Air Force, they were united in marriage on April 26, 1963. Scotty and Judy were blessed with three sons, Stan, Eric and Darin. Scotty had a successful career with the United States Postal Service. He also owned Scotty's Market in Fordland, Missouri, for several years. Scotty was 10 years old when he accepted Jesus as his Savior.
