A memorial had been established.



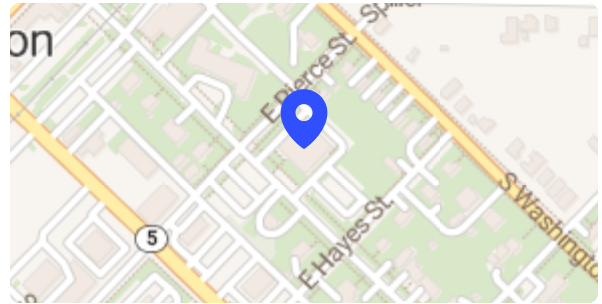

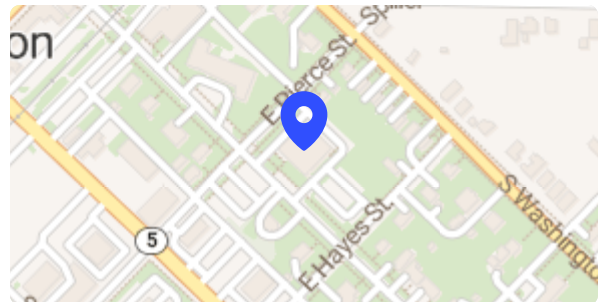

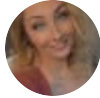
