## **Elizabeth Lee O'Dell (Lebanon)**

**E**lizabeth Lee O'Dell, daughter of James Leonard and Alma Elizabeth Holman O'Dell, was born January 13, 1937, in Lebanon, Missouri. She departed this life Tuesday, March 8, 2022, at Cox Medical Center South, in Springfield, Missouri, at the age of eighty-five years, one month, and twenty-three days.

She was preceded in death by her parents; a brother, Stanley O'Dell; a sister, Marlene Harmon (and her husband, Jones); and a sister, Sharon O'Dell.

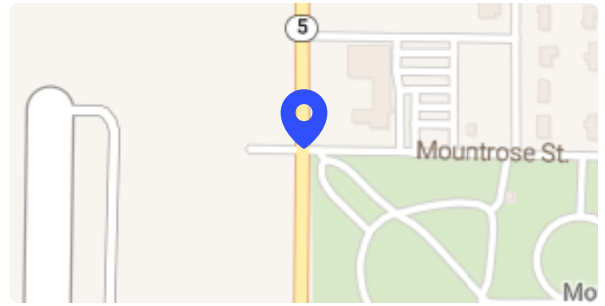
