He departed this life Thursday, March 17, 2022, in Lebanon South Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, in Lebanon, Missouri, at the age of seventy-eight years, seven months, and seventeen days.

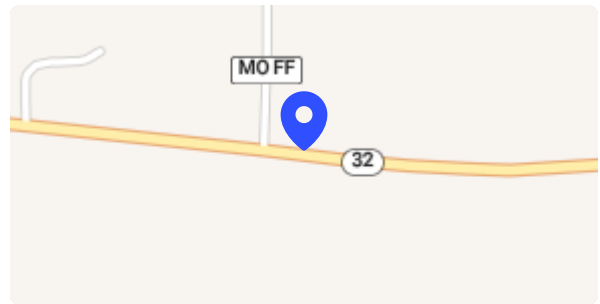

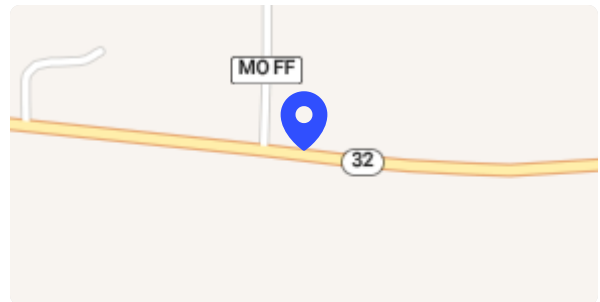
