**O**rval Earnest Smith, son of Earnest Oral and Gladys Pearl (Pleasant) Smith was born June 2, 1931 in Broseley, Missouri. He departed this life Sunday, April 11, 2010 in Glenwood Healthcare in Seymour, Missouri at the age of seventy-eight years, nine months, and twenty-two days. On October 15, 1966 he was united in marriage to Roberta J. Bugg and together they shared thirty-two years before her passing on September 25, 1998.
