Randy Mac Harris, son of Joe and Lois Helen McIntosh Harris, was born August 31, 1952 in Springfield, Missouri. He departed this life Monday, April 25, 2011, in Cox Medical Center, South Springfield, Missouri at the age of fifty-eight years, seven months, and twenty-four days.

On June 24, 2001, Randy was united in marriage to Pamela Ann Doyle and together they have shared the past nine years.

Randy was preceded in death by his parents and his maternal grandparents, Ruth and Rufus McIntosh.
